About the Ensembles

Men of Valor

Men of Valor is a vocal ensemble at the Boston Arts Academy, established in 2008. The men's choir consists of lower house students (9th and 10th grade), with upper house junior leadership. The strong voices of Men of Valor have become an integral part of the music program at BAA, and a dynamic instrument for outreach in the Boston Public schools. Men of Valor is directed by Jeffrey Colby.

Boston Children's Chorus

The Boston Children's Chorus harnesses the power and joy of music to unite our city's diverse communities and inspire social change. Our singers transcend social barriers in a celebration of shared humanity and love of music. Through intensive choral training and high-profile public performance experience (locally, throughout the U.S., and around the world), they learn discipline, develop leadership skills, and proudly represent the city of Boston as ambassadors of harmony. The Young Men's Ensemble is conducted by Artistic Director Anthony Trecek-King.

Young Men's Chorus

Established in 2006, Handel and Haydn Society Young Men's Chorus (YMC) provides young men with changing to changed voices (grades 8-12) a vigorous and musically challenging experience, with a mission to learn and perform repertoire from a variety of music ranging from classical to popular and multi-ethnic a cappella. The YMC has performed at Symphony Hall, the National Heritage Museum, Massachusetts Superintendents' Roundtable, Cutler Majestic Theatre, and the Society's 2011 Gala Ball at the Mandarin Oriental Hotel honoring legendary soprano Phyllis Curtin. YMC was selected to perform at the 2011 MMEA All-State Convention for a concert hour on March 25 at the Seaport Hotel, Boston. The Young Men's Chorus is conducted by Joseph Stillitano.

Yakootones

The North Quincy High School Yakootones, of Quincy, Massachusetts, is a young men's a cappella group established in 2006 by choral director Timothy Carew. Currently directed by high school junior William Lunny, the group performs arrangements of contemporary songs, barbershop classics, and traditional songs at school and community events.

WPI Men's Glee Club

Founded in 1874, the Worcester Polytechnic Institute (WPI) Men's Glee Club is one of the oldest glee clubs in the United States. In addition to its performances on campus and at other universities, the Glee Club tours to NYC each fall to sing with the Paul Winter Consort in the annual production of "Missa Gaia" and travels regularly to Europe, most recently to Ireland, Spain, and Italy. The Glee Club is supported by a very active Alumni Association which has established an Endowment for Choral Music on the WPI Campus. An auditioned subset of the Glee Club is Simple Harmonic Motion, a student directed a cappella group. The Glee Club is under the direction of John Delorey, Professor of Music and Theory at WPI.

Combined Men's Choirs

The combined men's choir features members of The Boston Conservatory Chorale, M.I.T. Chamber Chorus, and M.I.T. Concert Choir, conducted by Dr. William Cutter. A member of the conducting faculty at The Boston Conservatory for the past ten years, Dr. William Cutter conducts The Boston Conservatory Chorale and teaches graduate conducting. He is a lecturer in music and director of Choral Programs at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology where he conducts the M.I.T. Choir and Chamber Chorus. Dr. Cutter is the artistic director for The Boston Conservatory Summer Choral Intensive for high school vocalists.
